



Now Taking Applications for ESOL/Social Studies Teacher Global Village Project, Inc.

The Global Village Project, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that operates a Georgia-accredited special purpose middle school and mentoring program for refugee teenage girls with limited English proficiency and interrupted schooling. Our mission is to develop a strong educational foundation for each student within a caring community, using a strengths-based approach and intensive instruction in English language and literacy, academic subjects, and the arts. Located in Decatur, Georgia in space donated by the Decatur Presbyterian Church, the school's full day academic program serves approximately 45 students ages 11-18. Students pay no tuition, and transportation and lunch are also provided free of charge. In addition, GVP serves more than 75 students in its mentoring program, designed to support alumnae as they continue through high school and college. The school's unique strength lies in its community base. Nearly a hundred volunteers serve as classroom helpers, tutors and mentors and support students at GVP and as they transition into high school.

The Global Village Project (GVP) is truly unique and seeks an innovative, dynamic, and proven educator to teach ESOL & Social Studies. The educator in this position will support the social and emotional learning, acquisition of English, and academic content learning of students so that they achieve academic success at GVP and beyond.

This is a full-time 11-month teaching position with the following desired qualifications:

- Cross-certified (Social Studies & ESOL—Reading certification a plus)
- Primary and middle grades certifications preferred
- Three or more years teaching experience
- Demonstrated high-quality classroom instruction
- Experience developing, documenting, and differentiating curriculum
- Experience with and enthusiasm for arts integrated learning
- Experience working in a multicultural community
- Values aligned with the values, mission, and vision of GVP

- Strong collaborative experiences and skills
- Strong strategic planning and leadership abilities
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- A willingness to share knowledge and skills with other educators through presentations, observations, and publications
- Knowledge, experience, and interest in STEAM and technology integration a plus
- Experience directing and training volunteers in the classroom a plus
- Experience implementing an intensive reading program a plus
