Must be available to work at least 8 hours per week between hours of 8:30AM-5 PM M-F

Required Qualifications:

- Must be currently enrolled in an education program or closely related discipline, with an interest in ESOL, literacy, applied linguistics, refugee learners, and/or learners with limited previous formal education
- Cultural competency and understanding of working with marginalized communities
- Flexibility and a willingness to learn
- Passion for working with teenagers
- Patience and a positive attitude

Preferred qualifications:

- Experience working with English Language Learners, particularly refugees
- Foreign language proficiency desirable (Arabic, Nepali, and Burmese (Burmese, Rohingya, Karen, Chin) or African languages (Somali, Swahili, Kinyarwanda/Kirundi, Amharic) desirable but NOT required (please, apply anyway!)
