

Do you know how much you pay in Georgia state taxes?

Did you know that you can redirect some of that same money as a donation to Global Village Project?



How?

By signing up for the **Georgia Tax Credit Program** through Apogee123.org

Here's how to sign up:

1

Look up (or ballpark) how much you pay in state taxes each year. If you can't, **choose any amount** lower than the max for your filing type:

\$1000 for single - \$1250 for separate married - \$2500 for joint married - \$10,000 for pass-through (LLCs or S-Corps)

2

Go to **Apogee123.org** and "Get Started Apply Today"

3

Choose your filing type and fill in your contact information

4

Select **Global Village Project** as the recipient school and decide how much you want to pledge.



Click Submit, and you're done! **2 minutes** is all it took to transform some of the taxes you'll owe next year into scholarships for refugee girls at GVP!

What comes next:

In January 2019, you'll receive an email from Apogee telling you how much of your pledge has been approved for a tax credit. To receive the state tax credit and federal charitable deduction, you'll need to send a payment for the approved amount to Apogee Scholarship Fund by March 2019.

Apogee sends your payment to Global Village Project as scholarships for our students, so we can continue to cover the entire cost of their tuition, transportation, and daily lunch.

Then, when you're completing your 2019 taxes, you get a state tax credit AND a federal charitable deduction - 2 for 1 bonus!
