Student Registration Requirements

- Girls age 11 to 18 (age 11 by September 1);
- Refugees arriving in the U.S. within 3 years or less;
- Students must live in Dekalb County (Clarkston, Avondale Estates or Decatur - live near current bus routes);
- Attend an intake interview and assessment appointment in the Spring. A parent/guardian must accompany all prospective students for the intake session;
- Registration Documents: I-94 Card, Social Security Card, Health Insurance Card, 3231 and 3300 Medical Forms, and WIDA ACCESS/W-Apt test scores (recent school).

The Global Village Project is an innovative special purpose school for refugee girls and young women with interrupted schooling. Our **mission** is to develop a strong educational foundation for each student within a caring community using a strengths-based approach and intensive instruction in English language and literacy, academic subjects, and the arts.
