

STEAM Internship

Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math (STEAM) Interns work closely with the STEAM Coordinator and GVP teachers to support refugee English language learners in the classroom. This intern will gain valuable experience working with learners at a range of proficiency levels and with highly experienced STEAM teachers.

Schedule:

Must be available to work at least 10 hours per week, Monday-Friday. Preferred availability Mondays and Wednesdays; other days considered.

Intern responsibilities may include:

- Help organize and prepare STEAM activities for STEAM teachers
- Assist STEAM Teachers during STEAM classes and Guided Math each week, including working one-on-one with students
- Help develop STEAM curriculum and resources as needed
- Serve as a front office receptionist and greeter for all visitors, volunteers, and staff when necessary

Required Qualifications:

- Must be currently enrolled in an education program or closely related discipline, with an interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math, refugee learners, and/or learners with limited previous formal education
- Cultural competency and understanding of working with marginalized communities
- Flexibility and a willingness to learn
- Passion for working with teenagers
- Patience and a positive attitude

Preferred qualifications:

- Experience working with English Language Learners, particularly refugees
- Foreign language proficiency desirable (Arabic, Nepali, and Burmese (Burmese, Rohingya, Karen, Chin) or African languages (Somali, Swahili, Kinyarwanda/Kirundi, Amharic) desirable but NOT required (please, apply anyway!)
